

Import Ban on Russian Iron and Steel Products into the EU

Effective from 30 September 2023

Dear Sir or Madam,

We have recently received an increasing number of enquiries and notifications concerning the import ban on Russian iron and steel products into the European Union, effective from 30 September 2023.

In this context, we have contacted our key suppliers and manufacturers for the relevant product groups and requested confirmation of compliance with the applicable requirements. Based on the information available to us, we can confirm that, in principle, none of the metals used in the relevant products originate from Russian iron and steel products.

Although we have no indication that the information provided by our suppliers and manufacturers is incorrect, we cannot assume any liability for the accuracy or completeness of information originating from parties outside our own sphere of influence and control.

Due to the large number of corresponding customer enquiries, we are generally unable to complete customer specific questionnaires, forms or similar documents. We kindly ask for your understanding in this regard.
